Dear Prayer Partner,

Today I want to give you some updates:

From today, December 16th, on there is a shut down in Germany: That means all shops are closed, except groceries and drug stores. All schools are closed as well. You are only allowed to meet max. 5 persons from two households. In some areas you are not allowed to leave your house from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. (Lock down) This will last at least at least until January 10th.

There is a similar situation in the Netherlands until January 19th as well as in other European countries.

People have no possibilities for events, going to concerts, family meetings, parties and so on. Already now the rate of suicide went up about closed to twenty times higher compared to the years before.

Some weeks ago our son Gerrith picked up his children from kindergarten to visit to us for the weekend. Our grandchildren were so excited to see their grandparents that they shared this with the other kids. When Gerrith came to pick them up one little girl stated: I will not visit my grandparents, because if I do, they may die. Gerrith stated: Everybody must die. The girl answered: No, that is not true. Gerrith repeated: Everybody, must die, but the girl insisted, that this is not true... That is so typical for our country.

We want to ask you to pray for Germany and Europe in general, that they start to think about, for what they live, that they start to think about what will happen after death.

Please pray, that people will turn to God. That they turn away from their opinion, that there is no live after death and that there is no God, but humble themselves in front of God and accept Jesus for their savior.

Let's look on Jesus, who's birthday we celebrate, that He will come back one day.
